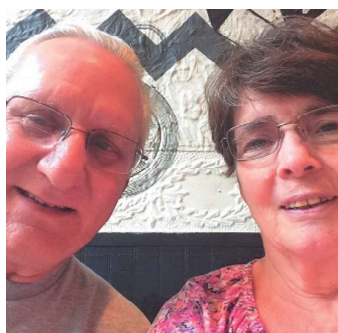

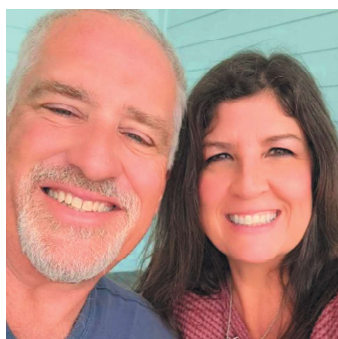
Area B - Mike & Joyce Danovi

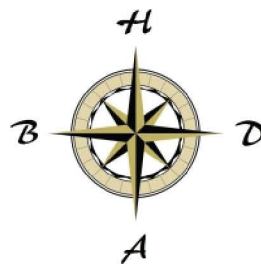

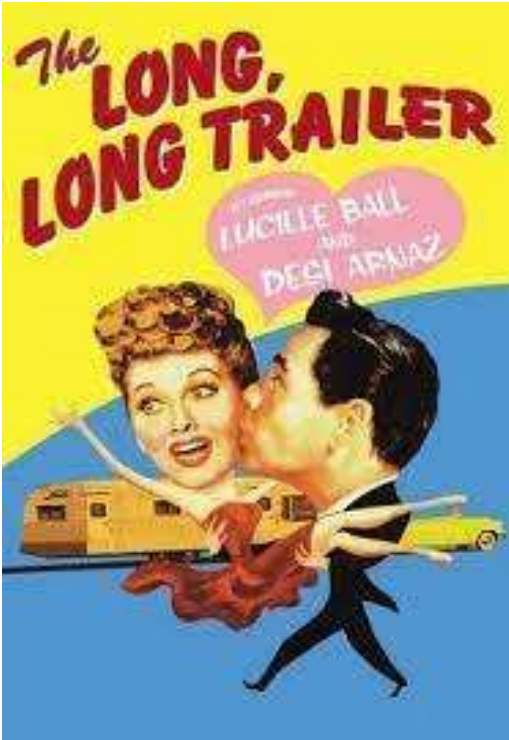
